Two vital principles

- 1. But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him.
- 2. That there should be no schism in the body; but that the members should have the same care one for another.

What is God seeking from man?

- God looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, that did seek God PSALM 53:2
- But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. JOHN 4:23
- But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. Hebrews 11:6

If there was no freewill:

- 1. There is no such thing as sin
- 2. There is no absolute standard of right and wrong
- 3. There is no personal accountability for decisions or choices
- 4. Decisions or choices are illusions
- 5. The *collective* concept of "the will of the people," that is, democracy, is meaningless if *individuals* do not have free will

Philosophical objections

- 1. Freewill is not compatible with foreknowledge if deity knows what is going to happen in advance, then man does not have free choice
- 2. Freewill which, by definition, enables moral evil to arise, is not compatible with a deity that is omniscient (all-knowing), omnipotent (all powerful) and omnibenevolent (wholly good)

Genetic determinism

- "Human existence is a life struggle for the preservation of genes
- "The racist ideology of the Nazi era was born out of this view of life
- "Competition (of which war is one form) is viewed as a tool to eliminate weaker genes and allow the stronger genes to advance and dominate

Human experience with freewill

- 1. The parent-child relationship
- 2. The husband wife relationship

In order to judge a situation, it is necessary to understand the purpose

- 1. The concern of Phinehas, the high priest, and the ten princes of Israel Joshua 22:12-20
- 2. The answer of the Reubenites, Gadites and half tribe of Manasseh Joshua 22:21-29
- 3. The conclusion of Phinehas and the ten princes of Israel Joshua 22:30-34

God is defined not by what is but by what will be

- But as truly as I live, all the earth shall be filled with the glory of the Lord NUMBERS 14:21
- For the earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord, as the waters cover the sea. HABAKKUK 2:14
- For the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea ISAIAH 11:9
